1 – Introduction

- The *full screen* backgrounds, which are the ones well suited for screen presentations, are managed by the \SeminarNewSlideFrameBackground and \SeminarSlideFrameBackground macros.^a
- We can overlap several partial *backgrounds* with the 'fancybox' package (using it \boxput macro), calling the \slideframe[*] macro, eventually several times (see the Seminar documentation and FAQ). See examples on slide 12 and in the file sem-dem2.pdf.
- IN We show here several kinds of backgrounds:
 - ➤ solid backgrounds,
 - **gradient** backgrounds, using the **pst-grad** PSTricks package,
 - **gradient** backgrounds, using the **pst-slpe** PSTricks package,
 - ➤→ composite backgrounds, based on PSTricks graphics (you can obviously rather use the others (▷)T_EX packages for algorithmic graphics),
 - ➡→ backgrounds with external images.
